Once in the stadium parents must stay in their seats and not walk around the bowl





The photo will take place under the posts in the South Stand in front of where you will be sat.



Pitch Layout for Pre-Match Game 1 12:15 – 12:40










Pitch Layout for Pre-Match Game 2 12:45 – 13:30


